

**Sewer Separation Project  
Construction Update  
For The Week of 21, 2011**

**Phase I Crew**

- Will remain on First St. and will be constructing the sanitary sewer between Perry and Lime Streets
- First St. will remain **closed to thru traffic**, but open to local residents, buses and emergency vehicles with the exception of when the contractor is working in the intersections of the cross streets – **at which time the cross street and First street will be closed to all traffic.**
- Weather permitting, the sanitary mainline construction on First St. between Water St. & Lime St. should be complete with the exception of the cross street mainline connections.

**Phase II Crew**

- Will begin construction at the east end of College Ave. - by the Portage River and JoJo's Lift Station.
- College Ave. from the river to Perry St. (including S. Perry St. from Main St. (US 20) to the river, will be **closed to thru traffic**, but open to local residents, buses and emergency vehicles with the exception of when the contractor is working in the intersections of the cross streets – **at which time the cross street and College Ave. will be closed to all traffic.**
- Other side streets on which construction will begin are those coming off of S. Perry and will include Erie St. from Perry to Cherry Sts, College Ave. between Perry and Elm Sts, and Cherry between College Ave. and Main St. As before, these streets will be open to local residents, buses and emergency vehicles except during cross street construction at which time the entire intersection will be **closed to all traffic.**

**Please Note: When crews are working in the intersections they will be closed to ALL TRAFFIC, based on safety implications this would have on the public while the contractor is setting the manhole structure in that intersection.**

**All schedules will be weather permitting**

**All sidewalks will be open**
